








Sumter School District 2017-2018 Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten Registration

Pre-kindergarten and kindergarten children must be four and five years old, respectively, on or before September 1, 2017 to register.

Required Documentation for Registration

- Official Birth Certificate
 - Proof of Residence
 - Physical Examination Form (Kindergarten Only)
 - Medicaid Card/Proof of Income (Pre-K Only)
 - South Carolina Immunization Form 2740
- All children are required to be immunized against diphtheria, tetanus, whooping cough, polio, mumps, chicken pox, red and German measles, and Hepatitis B.*

Sumter School District is currently holding pre-kindergarten and kindergarten registration for the 2017-2018 school year.

Kindergarten students must be five years old by September 1, 2017 to qualify.

The pre-kindergarten program is not state mandated, and there are a limited number of slots available at each school. To qualify for this program, students must be four years old on or before September 1, 2017. Students will be pre-screened using a state-approved instrument. Students who qualify must meet the family income eligibility table, Medicaid, or documented developmental delays.

Students must attend the school within their attendance zone. To register for these programs, parents should visit the school and bring the child's birth certificate, South Carolina Immunization Form 2740, proof of residence, and physical examination form. A Medicaid card/proof of income is also required for pre-kindergarten.
